SPECIAL MEETING - There will be a SPECIAL GENERAL PARISH MEETING on SUNDAY, 24 NOVEMBER, IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING DIVINE LITURGY. Discussion at this meeting will be limited to two subjects only: 1) the Potential sale of the "new" cemetery property and 2) the Official/legal establishment of the parish name. Only parishioners in good sacramental and financial standing, as defined by the current bylaws of our parish, will be allowed to participate. A member in good standing is defined in Article II Paragraph A Section 2 as:

- a. Conducting his/her life and. Activity in accordance with the Orthodox faith;
- b. Attending the Holy Liturgy and other church services;
- c. Observing thee rules of thee Orthodox Church concerning the Fasts;
- d. Going to Confession, partaking of Holy Communion on a regular basis; (1) At a minimum, Orthodox Christians should receive the Sacraments at least during the four fasting periods of the year or more. (CANON 12 of SARDICA and CANON 80 of the 6th Ecumenical Council TRULLO)
- e. Rearing his/her children and instructing them in the Orthodox faith and in the spirit of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church;
- f. Showing respect for the hierarchy, the clergy, and for church authorities;
- g. Paying the membership financial obligation and additional contributions according to the decision of the General Parish Meetings.
