Tone 5 Troparion (*Resurrection*)

Let us, the faithful, praise and worship the Word, co-eternal with the Father and the Spirit, born for our salvation of the Virgin. In His Good Will He was lifted up on the Cross in the flesh to suffer death and to raise the dead, by His glorious Resurrection

Tone 8 Troparion (*Holy Fathers*)

You are most glorious, Christ our God. You have established the Holy Fathers as lights on the earth. Through them You have guided us to the True Faith. O greatly Compassionate One, glory to You

Tone 5 Kontakion (*Resurrection*)

You descended into Hell, my Savior, destroying the gates as the Almighty, resurrecting the dead as Creator and destroying the sting of death. You have delivered Adam from the curse, Lover of all Mankind. Therefore, we all cry out to You: Lord, save us.

Tone 8 Kontakion (*Holy Fathers*)

The preaching of the Apostles and doctrines of the Fathers have confirmed one faith for the Church, adorned with the Robe of Truth, woven from heavenly theology. Great is the mystery of piety, which it defines and glorifies.
